By Faith – the ancient worthies gained God's approval – Hebrews 11:2



By faith Abraham dwelled in the promised land but in tents as if he lived in a foreign land . . . Hebrews 11:9




Heroes of Faith - Abraham

Hebrews 11:17


By faith Abraham received Isaac from the dead in a figure. Hebrews 11:19

By faith Moses refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God.




Hebrews 11:28-29







Daniel


- Taken from the promised land

Our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace . . .




Heroes of Faith – Courage and Meekness
