

Alive - New Reckoned Will









New Creature, within Old "Man" in the Flesh





Seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence.


For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become partakers of *the* divine nature, having **escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust**.

With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints.
