Gen 49:3 Reuben, you are my firstborn, my might and the first fruits of my vigor, excelling in rank and excelling in power.

Gen 49:4 Unstable as water, you shall no longer excel because you went up onto your father's bed; then you defiled it

Gen 35:22 And it came to pass, when Israel dwelt in that land, that Reuben went and lay with Bilhah his father's concubine: and Israel heard it. Now the sons of Jacob were twelve:

Gen 49:5 Simeon and Levi are brethren; instruments of cruelty... (Gen 49:6 NRSV) May I never come into their council; may I not be joined to their company—for in their anger they killed men, and at their whim they hamstrung oxen.

(Gen 37:2 CJB) Once when he was with the sons of Bilhah and the sons of Zilpah, his father's wives, Joseph brought a bad report about them to their father.

Gen 37:3 he made him a coat of many colors.

Gen 37:4 ...when his brethren saw... they hated him, and could not speak peaceably unto him.

Gen 37:7 we were binding sheaves in the field, and, lo, my sheaf arose, and stood upright; and, your sheaves stood round about, and made obeisance to my sheaf.

Gen 37:9 behold, the sun and the moon and the eleven stars made obeisance to me.

Gen 37:20 ...let us slay him, and cast him into some pit, and we will say,

Some evil beast hath devoured him:

Gen 37:26 What profit is it if we slay our brother, and conceal his blood? Gen 37:27 let us sell him to the Ishmaelites, and let not our hand be upon him; for he is our brother and our flesh. And his brethren were content. Gen 37:28 Then they sold Joseph to the Ishmaelites for twenty pieces of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt.

Gen 39:9 There is none greater in this house than I; neither hath he kept back any thing from me but thee, because thou art his wife: how then can I do this great wickedness, and sin against God?

Gen 41:40 Thou shalt be over my house, and according unto thy word shall all my people be ruled: only in the throne will I be greater than thou. Gen 41:41 And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, See, I have set thee over all the land of Egypt.

Gen 42:1 ...Jacob saw that there was grain in Egypt, Jacob said unto his sons, Why do ye look one upon another?

Gen 42:6 ...Joseph's brethren came, and bowed down themselves before him with their faces to the earth.

(Gen 42:7 NASB) "Where have you come from?" And they said, "From the land of Canaan, to buy food."

(Gen 42:9 NASB) "You are spies; you have come to look at the undefended parts of our land."

Gen 42:11 "We are all sons of one man; we are honest men, your servants are not spies."

(Gen 42:13 NASB) "Your servants are twelve brothers in all, the sons of one man in Canaan; the youngest is with our father, and one is no longer alive."

(Gen 42:19 NIV) If you are honest men, let one of your brothers stay here in prison, while the rest of you go and take grain back for your starving households.

(Gen 42:20 NIV) But you must bring your youngest brother to me, so that your words may be verified and that you may not die."

Gen 42:21 We are verily guilty concerning our brother, in that we saw the anguish of his soul, when he besought us, and we would not hear; therefore is this distress come upon us.

Gen 42:28 ...their hearts failed them, and they were afraid, saying one to another, What is this that God hath done unto us?

(Gen 42:34 NASB) 'bring your youngest brother to me that I may know that you are not spies, but honest men. I will give your brother to you, and you may trade in the land.'"

Gen 42:36 ... Me have ye bereaved of my children: Joseph is not, and Simeon is not, and now ye will take Benjamin away: all these things are against me.

Gen 42:38 ...Benjamin shall not go down with you; for his brother is dead, and he is left alone: if mischief befall him... then shall ye bring down my gray hairs with sorrow to the grave.

Gen 38:7 Er, Judah's firstborn, was wicked in the sight of the LORD; and the LORD slew him.
