Deu 16:5 Thou mayest not sacrifice the Passover within any of thy gates, which the LORD thy God giveth thee:

Deu 16:6 But <u>at the place which the LORD thy God shall choose to place his name in</u>, there thou shalt sacrifice the passover at even, at the going down of the sun, at the season that thou camest forth out of Egypt.

## The Typical Temple

1Ki 9:3 ... I have hallowed this **house** [**Temple**], which thou hast built, to put my name there forever; and mine eyes and mine heart shall be there perpetually.

2Ch 35:1 Moreover Josiah kept a Passover unto the LORD in **Jerusalem**: and they killed the Passover on the fourteenth day of the first month.

Ezr 6:18 And <u>they set the priests in their divisions</u>, and the Levites in their courses, for the service of God, which is <u>at **Jerusalem**</u>; as it is written in the book of Moses.

Ezr 6:19 And the children of the captivity [returned exiles] kept the Passover upon the fourteenth day of the first month.

Ezr 6:20 For <u>the priests and the Levites</u> were purified together, all of them were pure, and <u>killed the Passover for all the children of the captivity</u>, and for their brethren the priests, and for themselves.

Jesus at Passover with his family

Luk 2:41 Now his parents went to **Jerusalem** every year at the feast of the Passover.

## With the Destruction of the Temple

Jews can't observe Passover on the **14th of Nisan**, because the temple is destroyed. They celebrate the feast of unleavened bread beginning on the **15**<sup>th</sup>.

But God has placed His Name on the Body of Christ...

Act 15:14 Simeon hath declared how God at the first did visit the Gentiles, to take out of them <u>a people for his name</u>.

Psa 91:14 Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.

God's **NAME** is his plan of Ransom and Restitution.

So, we see and celebrate our Passover Lamb, through the Memorial.

1Co 5:7 Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even <u>Christ our Passover</u> is sacrificed <u>for us</u>:

1Co 5:8 Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

In The Mediation, when the Christ head and Body are teaching and blessing mankind, they will teach them God's true name, This is shown in the benediction on Num6:22-27

Num 6:22 And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying,

Num 6:23 Speak unto Aaron and unto his sons, saying, On this wise ye shall bless the children of Israel, saying unto them,

Num 6:24 The LORD bless thee, and keep thee:

Num 6:25 The LORD make his face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee:

Num 6:26 The LORD lift up his countenance upon thee, and give thee peace.

Num 6:27 And they shall put my name upon the children of Israel; and I will bless them.

And when God's name is placed upon them – the understanding of ransom and restitution, then they will see and appreciate the Passover Lamb.

The change made by God in Deu 16:5-6 makes the Passover for everyone, in due time.
